EXITS	√
Stairs have one (1) graspable hand-rail	
No storage of flammable/combustibles on, in, or under exits or escape paths	
Stair/Landing surface free of trip hazards	
Exits/Escapes require no key or tool from inside to open	
Each unit has one (1) means of escape with a clear opening measuring at least 5.7 square feet	
Battery powered emergency light illuminating primary means of exit	
Posted floor diagram showing primary exit and secondary escape	
Stair width clear of obstructions **Minimum recommended width: 36 inches**	
ALERTING	√
Hardwired smoke detectors in every bedroom	
Hardwired smoke detectors outside of every bedroom or group of bedrooms	
Hardwired smoke detectors in common areas and throughout all levels **Placement in garages and kitchens, not required**	
Visual smoke detectors available for hearing impaired occupants	
Battery powered smoke detectors test log available**Tested weekly**	
ELECTRICAL SAFETY	✓
No open spaces in breaker/fuse box	
Breakers/Fuses are labeled	
No exposed electrical wiring	
No "daisy chain" of extension cords	
Extension cords are in good condition; No signs of wear or damage	
PROTECTION	√
Fire extinguisher, minimum size 2A:10BC (requires a current state inspection tag from a licensed contractor)	
Dryer vent clear of lint	
No excessive storage of combustible or flammable material	
LP/Gas tanks are in good condition and within hydrostatic test date
